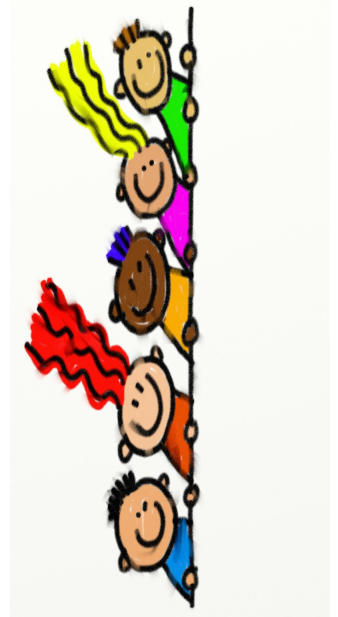

Supplies to be used at home:

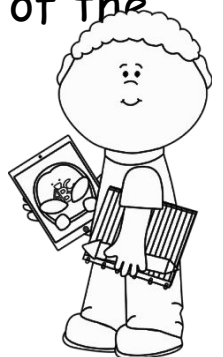
manuscript tablet (primary ruled)	crayons

zip-lock bags	pink block erasers

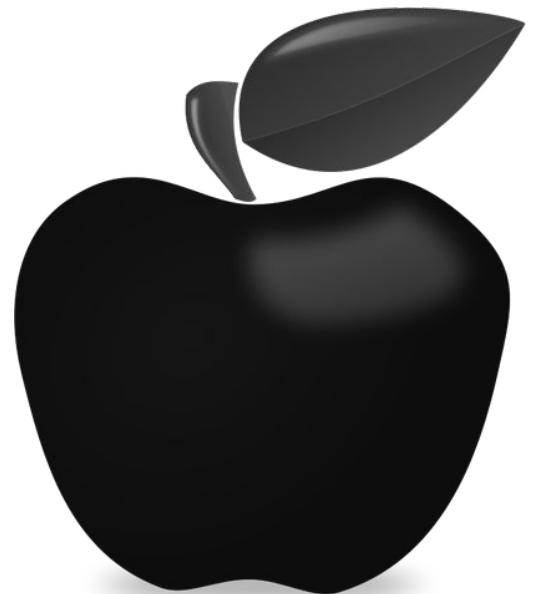


Second Grade Supply List

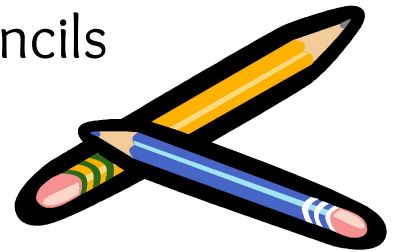
- Tissue

- A LOT of plain yellow number two pencils



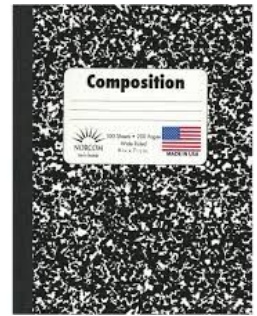
These items would be appreciated if you'd like to donate to the class:
